### How to add a medications to your MyChart

1. Under the “Health” Folder select **Medications**
2. Click on **ADD A MEDICATION**
3. Start typing the name of the medication to be added. A drop down screen will appear, select the medications you are searching for.
4. Click on the calendar icon and a calendar will pop up.
5. Add any additional comments
6. Once you have completed the form click on **ACCEPT** if you make a mistake click on the **GO BACK**

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## How to add a medications to your MyChart

### Medications



Please review your medications, and verify that the list is up to date. **Call 911 if you have an emergency.**

Not all medication refills can be processed through MyChart. Prescriptions from Hospital, Emergency Room or Urgent Care visits cannot be refilled through MyChart. Also, only providers that are with Eisenhower Medical Associates and Eisenhower clinics can refill prescriptions through MyChart. Providers with independent clinics cannot get refill requests, even if their clinic is located in a building on our campus.

Please allow 48 hours for refill requests to be processed - If you need a refill sooner, please contact your provider's office directly.
